We will have a short welcome and then we will walk a few steps away to the Shot Tower –this is one of the last remaining Shot Towers in the US and was once used to produce shot for the military. We will have a local historian on hand to give us a tour and a rare look at the inside staircase. The tower will be lit from inside for a sunset shoot (Sunset 7:15). Bring your camera, tripod and a wide lens. Shot Tower is 102 feet above ground. Free event. There may be a cancellation of the Shot Tower shoot if inclimate weather.

There are 20 illustrated volumes that took thirty years to produce including over 720 large-format photogravures. This is a rare and complete collection. Hear the stories and

view a few of over 40,000 photographs that he took in North America. Bring your own lunch.
