Dubuque architecture from a new perspective. *The images should be shot in a way that the architecture is not immediately identifiable.* No straight on shots of a church, no panoramas of the city. Look for unusual angles, close-ups, less well known perspectives like from an alleyway or of a back door or side window. Bring a new awareness and appreciation to Dubuque architecture by capturing it in a fresh way.

Images should be submitted in black and white. Preference will be given to images that are taken this year.

Each club member can submit up to 4 images. This may be reduced before submitting images to the DMA for approval. Criteria for these submissions will be high and fewer images may be accepted than in the past. Email images to info@digitaldubuque.com

All of the images will be printed at 12x18, so please submit images in a 2:3 aspect ratio. Print prices to be determined- we are looking at printing black and white on metal at a cost of approximately \$50-60 range each. Some artists may have more than one print.

Exhibition Timeline

March-May- shooting and editing of images, field trips, member discussion

June 6, 2016 final submission deadline- all images must be submitted by this date. Submissions do not have to be finalized images, lower res images are fine. Email to info@digitaldubuque.com Ronald Tigges

June 6-July 1- organization of images, DMA will jury images and make their selections

July 1-July 15 member selections will be announced and images compiled for printing, printing and signing of images. Artist agreements to be filled out and returned.

August 1 Delivery of images to DMA

August 5- October 23 – Exhibition on display. Thursdays are free admission days to the museum. Artist opening reception to be announced. Possible photography talk or guest speaker to be announced.

October 24, 2016 images picked up at DMA

October 24- November 7 image available for pickup or will be distributed to November 7th regular club meeting.
